## GLOW Cambodia (GLOW)

GLOW的服侍對象為柬埔寨中低收入家庭及有志培育下一代的教育工作者，以基督教理念在柬埔寨辦學及培訓當地老師，現時設有兒童日托中心、幼稚園、課餘學習班 (包括英文班、數學班、柬文班、中文班)、圖書館，及週末的成人英文班和老師培訓班，還有鄉村傳道人的培訓。

事工主要帶領者為鄭銘恩醫生夫婦。1979年，鄭醫生 (Dr. Andrew Kwong) 前往泰柬邊境救助難民，見證了柬埔寨人的苦難，從此一直惦念他們。1994年，鄭醫生偕同夫人鄭伍美甜 (Josephine) 姊妹，以宣教士身份前往柬埔寨服侍，建立了人力資源中心，又在聖經學校把許多渴慕主話語的當地人訓練成為聖經教師。

今日，柬埔寨局勢漸穩，但政局動盪遺害顯露，知識份子不足，教師青黃不接，新生孩子很多，教育卻不足夠。2014年，GLOW為回應當地人的迫切教育需要而成立，現時已有好幾批教牧同工、教師和孩童在這兒完成訓練和學業，在知識和生命上獲得改進。

作為一所全方位基督教教育機構，GLOW 獲當地政府信任和認可，將來可望爭取籌建更多學校，包括中、小學和大學。現在，神為GLOW預備了一塊合適的土地，現正積極進行籌建新校舍。求主使用 GLOW 和這塊土地，好讓基督的大愛在當地成為明燈，讓人心獲得真光照亮，與神和好。

### 加拿大傳仁基金會的參與：

1. 在金邊社區內資助開設一所圖書閱覽室，既鼓勵居民閱讀，學習英、華、柬語，亦可藉此與社區建立關係。
2. 於2017年8月曾派短宣隊前往協辦英語音樂營，得以協助學校做外展工作，事工反應良好，務求來年能續辦。
3. 在創辦學校上，提供專業教育意見及經濟資源。於2018年1月將派短宣隊前往與GLOW商討未來合作籌組成立中學和興建校舍事宜。
4. 正在招募中、短期同工加入當地教師團隊。
5. 提供助學金予家境清貧的學生及立志進修的老師。
6. 於2018年8月再次差派短宣隊協辦英語品格營。



## 封閉國家的信心夥伴（基於安全理由，恕不能公開名字，代稱之為“信心夫婦”）

神沒有忘記那些戰火繚亂、輕視生命、漠視人權及高壓統治的福音封閉國家。芸芸宣教士中有著這對“信心夫婦”，操得一口流利阿拉伯語，堅毅不懈的在中東地帶服侍超過三十年，效法基督的愛去體貼關心那流離失所、飽受戰火摧殘、為信仰受逼迫的群體的身心靈健康。現時已在多個據點建立起可靠的人際事工網絡，除了輸送物資支援災民外，主要默默牧養當地信徒領袖，激勵信徒們在絕望中仰望十架拯救的大能，在困境中祈求主賜內心的平安喜樂。

### 加拿大傳仁基金會的參與：

1. 補助當地同工生活費。
2. 供應、補給前線工場所需之物流。
3. 提供助學金予當地同工進修。
4. 計劃到教會分享中東一帶主內肢體的呼求與需要，激發基督徒多認識、多關心並積極參與支持回教國家事工。
5. 計劃邀請資深導師暨培靈師傅 (Spiritual Mentors) 培育訓練有負擔的信徒，幫助肯定召命，向高處行。



## 康泉醫療協進會 HEALING HOPE ORGANIZATION (HHO)

HHO抱著營商宣教的態度，藉著醫療工作去實踐基督的愛。HHO現時在廣東省內參與營運綜合醫院、敬老院及職業培訓中心各一。秉承著全人關懷的理念，醫院及敬老院向當地平民及外省勞工提供信譽可靠的醫療及安老服務，而收費則是一般平民百姓負擔得起的。至於職業培訓中心，HHO經常從國外引入專才，向醫療人員提供職場培訓，並傳授應有的醫德操守，建立有愛、有生命素質的優良醫療團隊。

負責HHO事工的團隊有劉牧師、馮弟兄、高姊妹、香港和中國內地一群愛主的同工。馮弟兄在香港及中國從事生產高科技醫療器材多年，經常慷慨捐贈藥物及醫療器材給予不同醫療宣教團體。高姊妹擁有豐富行政管理經驗，現於香港一醫療器材公司任職行政管理。

### 加拿大傳仁基金會的參與：

1. 差派醫療專業、心理輔導、社工等導師到醫院、敬老院及職業培訓中心服侍。
2. 經濟資助，特別在添置醫療器材方面。
3. 經濟資助〈愛回家〉計劃 ~ 捐贈一部復康小巴，能運載輪椅，方便接送獨居老人從敬老院回鄉探訪，並聘請社工陪同。
4. 於2018年8月下旬，組織短期服務隊往中國，與HHO合辦品格夏令營及親子講座。

## Faith partner in countries closed to the outside world

( We call our partner the “couple of faith” who have to remain anonymous for personal safety reasons )

God has certainly not forgotten the world's many war-torn corners suffering under autocratic regimes and ruthless oppression – countries where human rights are grossly abused and trampled upon; places where sanctity of life is not regarded nor respected; areas where the bright light of the Gospel has yet to reach and shine forth. Among the soldiers of missionaries is this “couple of faith” nestling in the Middle East. Imitators of the love of Christ, for over 30 years this couple has steadfastly worked in the region to reach out and care for those who are forgotten, whose homes have been destroyed, whose lives have been turned upside down and utterly ruined by endless wars and fights. Exercising their gift to speak fluent Arabic, they have tirelessly tended to the needs – both physical and spiritual – of the weak and the poor and the hard-pressed, and of those who were persecuted because of their faith. As a result of their work and labor, pockets of ministry networks have been established to reliably and dependably deliver aid and supports to refugees. The network also serves to bring in supplies and help to nurture the local Christian leaders, to help believers to look up to the power of the cross despite all despair and difficulties around, to seek the inner peace and joy from above in midst of all abiding sufferings and abounding hardships.

### Involvement of Go and Love Foundation Canada:

1. To subsidize the cost of living of the local co-workers in the region.
2. To supply and replenish the needs of the frontline mission field.
3. To provide financial assistance to local co-workers to acquire further training.
4. To plan and organize sharing meetings in Toronto churches to share the call and the needs of other members in the Body of Christ in the Middle East; to encourage local Christians to step out – to know, to care, to support and to get involved in the ministry serving the Muslim World in the Middle East.
5. To look into inviting qualified and experienced Spiritual Mentors to train and to envision believers who have the burden to join the ministry; to help them to ascertain and to respond to the call, to embark onto an upward journey.



## HEALING HOPE ORGANIZATION ( HHO )

Strategically niching to run mission work under the operation of a business, HHO aims to manifest and practice the love of Christ through services in the medical field. HHO is currently operating a full-scale general hospital, a senior home, and a vocational training centre in the province of Guangdong, China. Adhering to their precepts of offering holistic care, the hospital and the senior home have been providing both reputable and professional medical care as well as dependable senior care to the local residents and out-of-province workers alike. Fees charged for providing the care and services is kept at a modest level affordable by local residents. Through the efforts of the vocational training centre to bring in foreign experts and specialists, HHO is also engaged in providing opportunities to help medical staffs to further their career through job training and ethics training, to build up a quality medical team excelling in both professional skills and ethical standards.

The HHO ministry is operating under the leadership of Rev. Lau, brother Fung, sister Ko, and a team of Christian workers from Hong Kong and China. Mr. Fung is a successful and well-respected businessman in Hong Kong and China. His business is involved in manufacturing and marketing high-end medical equipment and instruments. For many years Mr. Fung has been very generous and supporting to donate both medicine and equipment to various medical mission works free of charge. Ms. Ko has many years of management experience, she is currently serving as an executive in a medical equipment company in Hong Kong.

### Involvement of Go and Love Foundation Canada:

1. To send medical professionals, counselors and social workers to serve in the hospital, senior home and vocational training centre.
2. To provide financial aid, particularly in the area of medical equipment purchase.
3. To provide financial assistance in the 〈 Love-Go-Home 〉 project, to donate a Rehab mini-bus that is capable of loading a wheelchair to facilitate transporting seniors for various visit purposes. To hire a social worker to provide transportation care.
4. To organize a short-term service team to China in late August 2018, to run joint programs with HHO including character-building summer camps and parents-kids forums.





## GLOW Cambodia (GLOW)

GLOW aims to serve families of low-to-mid income in Cambodia, as well as local educators aspiring to bring better education to the next generation. GLOW runs schools and provides teacher training programs based on Christian values and principles. Current facilities include day-care center for pre-school children, kindergarten, after-school learning classes in Math and language subjects like English, Khmer (Cambodian language), and Chinese. It also runs library, weekend adult English classes and teacher training, and conducts special training for Christian workers serving in the rural area.

The GLOW ministry has been under the leadership of Dr. Andrew Kwong and his wife. Dr. Kwong first travelled to the Thai-Cambodia border at the height of the Indo-Chinese refugee crisis in 1979. Not only was Dr. Kwong able to help relieve the refugees, he became a first-hand witness of the appalling and grim situations of many Cambodians and their dire and grave sufferings – something that had lingered and stayed with him long since. In 1994, Dr. Kwong went into Cambodia again, this time as missionaries together with his wife Josephine. Over the years they have established a centre for human resources, as well as offered training to prepare many locals who hunger and thirst for God's Word to become Bible teachers.

Today Cambodia is facing the many sequelae of a once prolonged political chaos and turmoil that overran the country decades ago – even though at long last stability has been restored. Lacking intellectuals, retiring school teachers now find it hard to recruit new teachers to pass on and to carry the torch of education. With thriving birth rate in the country, the inadequate education machine scrambles to meet the needs of the younger generation. GLOW was founded in 2014 in response to the urgent and pressing need to provide education to local Cambodians. Scores of ministry workers, teachers and school children have already received training and education through GLOW, to get on to life better equipped in intellect knowledge and inner maturity.

As a full-fledged Christian education organization, GLOW is recognized and endorsed by the government. It is hopeful that in future GLOW would be granted to build even more schools – elementary and high schools, even universities. At this point, God has already secured for GLOW a piece of land suitable to erect school buildings. GLOW is actively pursuing on planning the building project. May the Lord use GLOW and this piece of land, through which the bright light of the great love of Christ will shine forth in the land of Cambodia – that many hearts may receive the true light, and many souls may reconcile back to the true God.



### **Involvement of Go and Love Foundation Canada:**

1. To finance and sponsor a reading-room facility in Phnom Penh, to promote reading and learning of languages like English, Chinese and Khmer, to establish a contact and a connection with the local community.
2. A short-term mission team travelled to Cambodia in August 2017 has helped GLOW to run a summer camp (English & Music camp), and assisted the school's outreach program in the community. Encouraged by positive responses, we hope to run the mission trip again in 2018.
3. To provide professional consultation service and financial resource assistance in the new school project, we will send another short-term mission team to Cambodia in January 2018 to engage in planning future joint efforts with GLOW in building and establishing the new high school.
4. We are in the process to recruit short-term and mid-term co-workers to join the local team of teachers.
5. To provide scholarship and bursary assistance to the students from low income families, and provide professional development to aspiring teachers.
6. To send short-term mission team to run the English character-building summer camp again in August 2018.
